PUBLIC WORKS DEPT. MONTHLY REPORT AUGUST, 2007



August found the Public Works Department busily preparing for the Paving Project which began on the 2nd week of the month. Prior to paving, numerous high spots were milled down, weeds along the curbs were removed and driveways were prepared for paving. Handwerk out of Hummelstown was contracted to resurface the following streets: Center Drive, Colgate Drive, Creekwood Drive, Old Mill Drive, Palmer and Hartzdale Drives, St. Johns Road, Wentworth Drive, 21st Street, and Winston Drive. The completed paving project came in under budget.

To correct a drainage problem in the area, the Olmstead Way Channel Project began during the month and is continuing

In addition to the above, the Public Works Department also completed the following:

1. Street sweeping township streets before and after paving
2. Street sweeping Shiremanstown
3. Five (5) new street signs, 12 No Parking Signs, 40 Permit Parking Signs and 20 signs were either repaired or replaced
4. Cleaned LASC drain pipe; patched 30th St. drain pipe, and repaired Creek Rd. drain pipe. Drain boxes repaired on Briar, Neponsit, Center, Chatham, Letchworth, and Olmstead Way.
5. Installed a drain top at St. Johns Rd.
6. Caulked ADA ramps
7. Sealed mailbox at Township building and delivered 50 recycle bins
8. Blacktopped areas on Creek Road, Allendale Way, Green Lane Drive and low spots on Yetter Field pathway
9. Installed light at Beacon Hill Park,
10. Built equipment box for Public Safety Vehicle
11. Repaired parking blocks at township office
12. Pothole repair
13. Four barricades delivered to Elmhurst for block party
14. Roadside mowing & Tri-Deck mowing areas of the township
15. Wood chip deliveries
16. 260 loads of brush dropped off by township residents; 13 loads dropped off by York Disposal and 19 loads dropped off at the composting facility on the 2nd Saturday of the month

The Parks crews continued mowing township parks (Allendale, Beacon Hill, Radar Site, Highland Park, Highland Estates Park, Sheepford Park, Creekwood Park, retention ponds and right-of-ways. General maintenance work at Wass Park including: Five (5) new parking blocks in parking lot next to the pavilion, six (6) new posts including rope, applied wood chips and re-seeded grass area, sidewalks were edged, top dressing added to outfield of Yetter Field followed by seeding, warning track maintenance, and straw matting added to outfield area.

No Parking signs and bollards were installed at the Boat Launch Area. Wood chips were added around the bollards.

The following additional Parks work was completed:

1. Ball field maintenance (7 fields)
2. Volleyball court maintenance
3. Installed signs at Creekside soccer Area
4. Secured picnic tables to concrete at Highland Park playground
5. Information sign painted at Highland Estates playground
6. Prepped parks for National Night Out
7. New garage door installed at LACP Maintenance Bldg.
8. LACP Mowing and trimmiking
9. Dog Park litter and park litter picked up
10. Barbecue pit painting
11. Trimmed nature trail
12. Painted over vandalism in men's restroom area
